**Job Options BC - Richmond/Ladner** is a 10-week comprehensive employment focused training program designed to help unemployed local residents find new employment opportunities

## Eligibility

To be eligible for this program you must be:

- Living in Richmond or South Delta
- 18 years of age or older
- Unemployed and legally entitled to work in Canada
- Non-EI eligible (not on EI at present and have not had a claim within the past 3 years or maternity/parental claim within the past 5 years)
- Not a student
- Able to make a 10-week commitment
- \* *Priority is given to individuals who are experiencing greater challenges in securing employment*

## Program Overview

- 4-5 weeks of comprehensive in-class employability skills training with training allowance followed by 4-5 weeks of work experience with wage subsidy
- Customized support for employment preparation and where appropriate, access to short-term training programs
- One to one employment counselling and job placement support
- Support and follow up assistance for up to six months
- Access to various industry employers for up-to-date employment trends and hiring practices
